
Piro Piro Piccolo

We wanted to make a second label to expand our line of wines and offer elegant wine in an informal package.



2006 Piro Piro Piccolo Chardonnay Sta. Rita Hills

Vineyard Notes: This sandy loam vineyard is in the far west part of the appellation.

Winemaking Notes: The wine was tank fermented and barreled for ten months in used French oak. 100% ML

Tasting Notes: Tropical notes of pineapple and pear with lemon and a cinnamon spice combine with a surprisingly food-friendly acidity. Full ML, a mellow oak profile, and balanced alcohol yield a medium bodied wine that's easy to quaff.

2006 Piro Piro Piccolo Pinot Grigio Sta. Rita Hills

Vineyard Notes: This sandy loam vineyard is in the far west part of the appellation.

Winemaking Notes: The wine was tank fermented and barreled for ten months in used French oak. 100% ML

Tasting Notes: This is not a garden-variety PG. It's golden, rich, and has a buttery mouthfeel. Green apples and lemon fruits create a lipsmacking quality. The weight of this wine and touch of vanilla oak persist on the palate.
